



AREVA Steam Generator Transport Project Schedule and Route

Note: Travel days and dates are for estimating purposes only. Actual travel schedule is contingent upon a variety of factors, including weather and other unforeseen delays.

Monday, 9/14: Maryland-Pennsylvania border to Route 272 W

- Transport crosses MD/PA border early morning and travels on U.S. Route 1 Northbound.
- Convoy will travel 272 W, ending the day approximately mid-afternoon at designated overnight location.

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Tuesday, 9/15: Continue travel on Route 272 W

- Transport continues on Route 272 W and crosses Octoraro Creek bridge early morning.
- Continue travel on 272 W, ending travel day late morning - early afternoon at designated overnight location.

Wednesday, 9/16: Cross Conowingo Creek to Highway 272

- From early to mid-morning the transport will cross three bridges – at Little Conowingo Creek, the tributary to Conowingo Creek, and then at Conowingo Creek.
- The convoy will meet the junction of Highway 272 mid-to-late morning and continue on Highway 272 NB for the remainder of the travel day.



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Thursday, 9/17: Travel Highway 272, cross Pequea Creek

- Continue travel on Highway 272 NB, cross junction of Highway 372 early morning.
- Mid-morning the transport will cross the bridge at tributary to Pequea Creek.
- Mid-to-late afternoon the transport will cross the bridge at Pequea Creek.
- Transport will continue on 272 NB until it reaches designated overnight location.

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Friday, 9/18: Continue on Highway 272, turn on Highway 741

- Transport will begin the day traveling NB on 272 and turn left onto Highway 741 (Long Lane).
- Mid-morning the convoy will cross the junction at Highway 324, then the junction of New Danville Pike.
- In approximately the early afternoon the transport is expected to cross the junction of Stehman Rd. and will continue on SR 3030 for the remainder of the travel day.

Saturday, 9/19 – Sunday, 9/20: Weekend stop. No travel.

Monday, 9/21: Steam Generator 1 crosses Conestoga River

- Early morning the transport will cross the bridge at Stehman Run and travel on Conestoga Boulevard.
- The convoy will then cross the bridge at the tributary to the Conestoga River (Boy Scout Rd.)
- By early afternoon the transport will begin the turn onto River Rd.
- The remainder of the travel day will be spent moving Steam Generator 1 over the bridge at the Conestoga River.



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Tuesday, 9/22: Steam Generator 2 crosses Conestoga River

- Steam Generator 2 will cross the Conestoga River.

Wednesday, 9/23: Travel on River Rd.

- The transport will begin early morning traveling on River Rd. (SR 3030) and will continue on River Rd. for the remainder of the travel day.

Thursday, 9/24: Travel through Washington and Columbia Boroughs

- The transport will begin the day traveling on River Rd. and then will make a left turn at the junction of Letort Rd.
- Early morning through early afternoon the convoy will pass Turkey Hill Dairy and then cross the bridges at Wissler's Run, Witmer's Run, and Dry Run.
- For the remainder of the afternoon the transport will go by Washington Borough Park and begin travel on Route 441, crossing bridges at Stamen's Run, Schuman's Run, Strickler Run, and Shawnee Run into Columbia Borough.

Friday, 9/25: Columbia Borough

- Transport will travel in Columbia Borough on Front St., Bridge St., Second St., and Linden St. Distance traveled today will be minimal as the convoy traverses downtown Columbia Borough.

Saturday, 9/26 – Sunday, 9/27: Saturday night move

- Saturday night through Sunday morning the transport will move onto Bar St. in Columbia Borough and then cross U.S. Route 30 on the way to Chiques Creek.

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Monday, 9/28: Cross Chiques Creek

- Transport will continue on 441 on the way to Chiques Creek.
- Convoy will cross Chiques Creek approximately mid-to-late afternoon.
- In the early evening the transport will cross the junction of Highway 23 and then cross the bridge at the tributary to the Susquehanna River.
- The convoy will then continue on Route 441 past the intersection of SR 743 and will continue on Route 441 until it reaches the designated overnight location.

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Tuesday, 9/29: Continue on Route 441

- The transport will begin the day on Route 441 and will cross the bridge at Bowman's Run.
- Approximately mid-morning the convoy will turn right onto Engle Rd. At the end of Engle Rd. it will turn left onto Stackstown Rd.
- The transport will follow Stackstown Rd. until it re-joins Route 441 in approximately the early afternoon.
- By mid-afternoon the transport will cross the junction of Highway 241 and continue on Route 441 for the remainder of the travel day.

Wednesday, 9/30: Arrival at TMI

- Through the morning the transport will continue on Route 441, crossing bridges at a tributary to the Susquehanna River, Snitz Creek, Stoney Run, and Conewago Creek.
- The steam generators will arrive at the TMI gate approximately early afternoon.
